

Summer Safety Tips For **CAT OWNERS**

Keeping Your Cat Cool and Comfortable in Summer

CREATE A COMFORT ZONE

- Ensure access to shaded or air-conditioned rooms
- Use cooling mats or damp towels

STAY HYDRATED

- Always provide fresh water
- Consider adding ice cubes to water for extra cooling

PROTECT FROM THE SUN

- Limit sun exposure during peak hours (10 AM - 4 PM)
- Apply pet-safe sunscreen especially for white or light-colored cats

SIGNS OF HEATSTROKE

- Excessive panting or drooling
- Lethargy or uncoordinated movement

ADJUST THEIR DIET

- Feed smaller meals more often
- Incorporate wet food to aid hydration

SUMMER GROOMING

- Regular brushing to remove loose fur
- Consider a lion cut to help keep cool if your cat has very long fur
